House Rules

- **Overdue books incur a fine** €50 per item p.w. for one week and €1 per item for subsequent weeks.
- **Lost / non-returned books** must be replaced or a charge of €40 or the current publication price (whichever is greater) will apply.

1. **First join the Librarika GENERAL database.**
This is at url: <https://librarika.com/users/register>
Register for a new account with email & password.
2. Librarika will send you a **verification email** with a link. **Click to verify.** This takes you to the 'My Libraries' page.
3. Next, from 'My Libraries' page, **join the Cork City Partnership (CCP) Librarika database.**

Click '**request member access**' (on right) & enter the URL of CCP community drug & alcohol library **<https://ccp.librarika.com>**
4. **You are now a member!** Members can view what's in stock and available to borrow, or reserve in advance if an item is out on loan.
